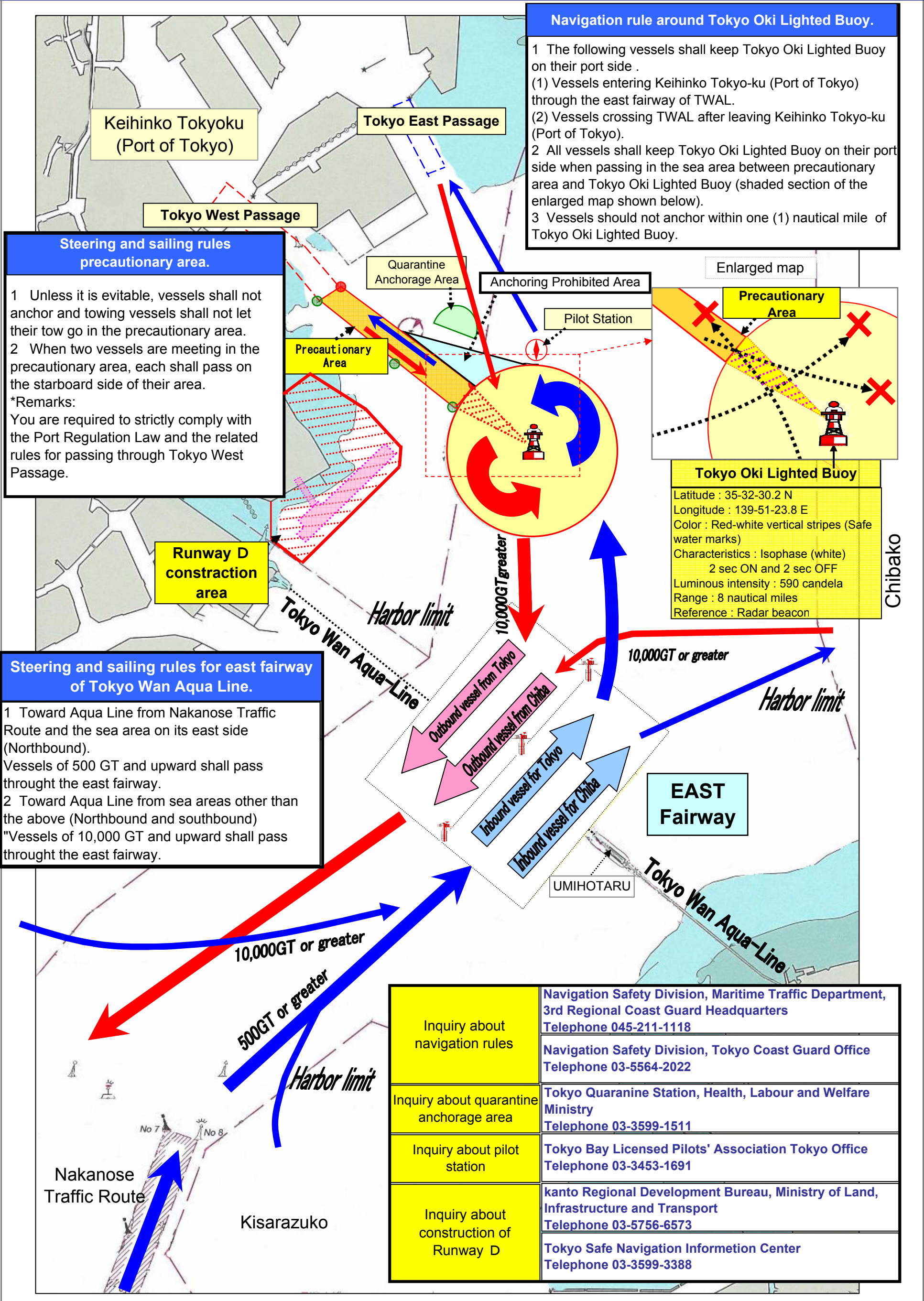


Steering and sailing rules in Keihinko Tokyo-ku (Port of Tokyo) and the Adjacent water, as well as in the vicinity of Tokyo Wan Aqua Line (TWAL)

With the construction of Runway "D" at Tokyo International Airport, steering and sailing rules in Keihinko Tokyo-ku (Port of Tokyo) and the adjacent water, as well as in the vicinity of Tokyo Wan Aqua Line (TWAL), shall be coming into force on **August 1, 2007**.



Navigation rule around Tokyo Oki Lighted Buoy.

- The following vessels shall keep Tokyo Oki Lighted Buoy on their port side .
 - Vessels entering Keihinko Tokyo-ku (Port of Tokyo) through the east fairway of TWAL.
 - Vessels crossing TWAL after leaving Keihinko Tokyo-ku (Port of Tokyo).
- All vessels shall keep Tokyo Oki Lighted Buoy on their port side when passing in the sea area between precautionary area and Tokyo Oki Lighted Buoy (shaded section of the enlarged map shown below).
- Vessels should not anchor within one (1) nautical mile of Tokyo Oki Lighted Buoy.

Steering and sailing rules precautionary area.

- Unless it is evitable, vessels shall not anchor and towing vessels shall not let their tow go in the precautionary area.
- When two vessels are meeting in the precautionary area, each shall pass on the starboard side of their area.

*Remarks:
You are required to strictly comply with the Port Regulation Law and the related rules for passing through Tokyo West Passage.

Steering and sailing rules for east fairway of Tokyo Wan Aqua Line.

- Toward Aqua Line from Nakanose Traffic Route and the sea area on its east side (Northbound).
Vessels of 500 GT and upward shall pass through the east fairway.
- Toward Aqua Line from sea areas other than the above (Northbound and southbound)
"Vessels of 10,000 GT and upward shall pass through the east fairway.
