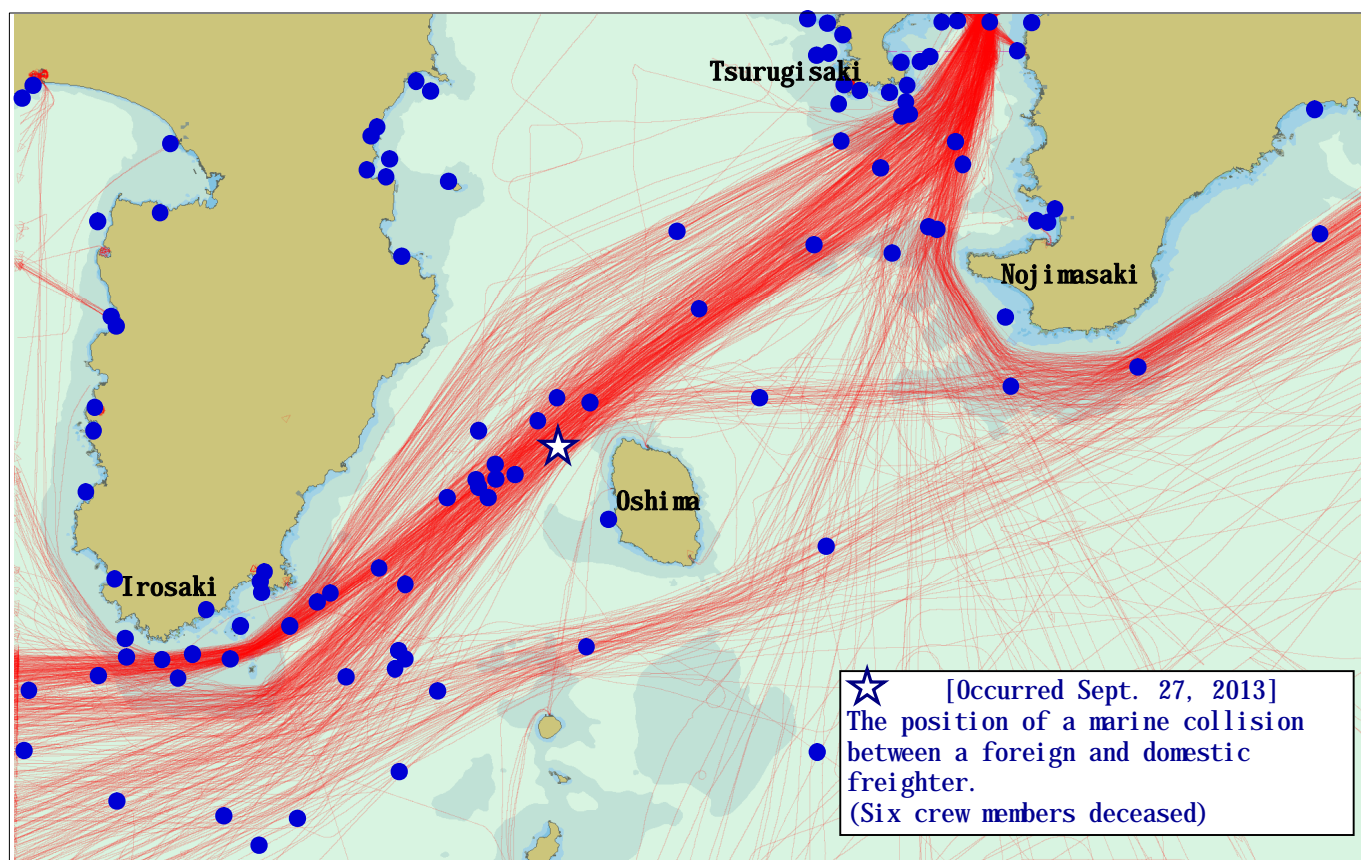


# For Preventing Marine Accident by Collision

The status of vessel traffic (red line -) and the locations of collision occurred in the past 10 years (blue dot ●)



## Maintain a proper look-out at all times !

◎According to traffic congestion and visibility conditions ( EX : restricted visibility due to night-time or Dense Fog , etc . ) , you need to check the other vessels' movements by proper look-out using rader , AIS , etc .

## Communicate with other vessels !

◎For your safety , adequately communicate with other vessels by VHF about how to pass each other before risk of collision arises in a case of "Head-on situation" or "Crossing situation" .

## Take proper actions to avoid Collision

◎If you take actions to avoid a collision , you need to take it in ample time, obvious enough to be readily apparent to other vessels.

◎After taking actions, you need to carefully check the effectiveness of the action until the other vessel is finally past and clear.
